BAC RESOLUTION NO. 2024-406

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THAT THE PROCUREMENT OF MONOBLOC CHAIRS WITH BACKREST FOR THE CITY COLLEGE OF ORMOC BE DONE THROUGH THE ALTERNATIVE MODE OF PROCUREMENT, PARTICULARLY THROUGH NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT (SMALL VALUE PROCUREMENT) PER RULE XVI OF THE REVISED IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT 9184.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 10 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 9184, as a general rule, Procuring Entities shall adopt public bidding as a general mode of procurement, however, in order to promote economy and efficiency and during exceptional cases, it may resort to alternative modes of procurement such as Negotiated Procurement as provided in Rule XVI of the said Implementing Rules;

WHEREAS, to promote economy and efficiency and to address the urgent need of the City College of Ormoc of monobloc chairs with backrest, the Bids and Awards Committee recommends that the procurement of the same be done through Small Value Procurement per Section 53.9 of RA 9184, considering that the amount involved which is Php 288,000.00 does not exceed the maximum amount of One Million Pesos (Php 1,000.000.00), which is the threshold for first class cities, as shown in the attached Purchase Request No. 240789;

WHEREAS, on March 05, 2024 Request for Quotation was posted at the Government Electronic Procurement System (G-EPS) at the BAC Bulletin located at the New Ormoc City Hall Building, at the Superdome and the Bus Terminal, Ormoc City and sent to the following Suppliers for the Procurement of Monobloc Chairs with Backrest for the City College of Ormoc to wit:

- 1. Pito Enterprises
- 2. Alvi Marketing
- 3. Uni-Real Trading Corporation

WHEREAS, in response to the said posting and RFQ's Sent, March 11, 2024, the following suppliers submitted their respective quotation to wit:

- 1. Uni-real Trading Corporation Php 271,200
- 2. Alvi Marketing Php 288,000

WHEREAS, Uni-Real Trading Corporation with business address at Osmeña St(s), District 23, Ormoc City, Submitted the lowest responsive price quotation with the total amount of TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED PESOS ONLY (Php 271,200.00) as shown in attached Abstract of Quotation dated March 11, 2024;

On mass motion, considering the foregoing premises, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved,
